MONTHLY WEATHER REPORT

THE WEATHER IN NOVEMBER 2018

<u>General Weather Conditions</u>: The weather in November was relatively warm. The area average precipitation in November was around normal. Unstable weather conditions occurred on the 4th and during the periods 8-11, 13-15, 21-26 and 29-30 of the month, giving local showers, isolated thunderstorms and hail over some areas. The mean air temperature was approximately 1.5°C above normal and the area average precipitation was 48.7mm i.e. 91% of normal.

<u>Severe Weather conditions</u>: On the 21st of the month, heavy rainfall caused difficulties in Larnaka area. On the 23rd of the month, waterspouts were observed in the sea areas of Limassol and Agia Napa. On the 29th and 30th of the month, severe rainfall with hail and strong winds caused difficulties in the areas of Paphos, Limassol and Larnaka. On the 30th of the month, waterspout was observed in the sea area of Limassol

Precipitation (normal period: 1961-1990): According to preliminary estimates the area average precipitation in November was 48.7mm i.e. 91% of normal. The area average precipitation was above normal inland and over west and south coastal areas and generally it ranged from 34% (Agios Ioannis Malountas) to 432% (Acheleia) of normal.

Hail was recorded on the 4th (Kyperounta, Athienou), on the 23rd (Troodos) and during the period 29-30 (Avdimou, Kalopanagiotis, Troodos, Kykkos) of the month.

The cumulative area average precipitation during the period October-November 2018 was about 105.9mm i.e. 123% of normal. In general, the cumulative area average precipitation ranged from 17 (Aradippou) to 293% (Galata) of normal.

Temperature (normal period: 1981-2010): The mean air temperature for the month was approximately 1.5°C above normal. Mean daily temperatures were below normal during the periods 4-5 and 15-17 and on the 24th of the month, while during the rest of the days the mean daily temperatures were above or around normal. Relatively high temperatures were recorded during the periods 1-2 and 6-7 of the month. Maximum temperatures exceeded 22°C at Athalassa and Larnaka Airport on 24 and 23 occasions respectively and at Prodromos they exceeded 13°C on 20 occasions. Most stations recorded their highest maximum temperature during the period 15-17 and on the 26 of the month.

The 5-day averages of air temperature and their deviations from normal at various places are shown in Table 1 and the extreme temperatures are shown in Table 2.
