### **MONTHLY WEATHER REPORT**

## THE WEATHER IN MARCH 2018

<u>General Weather Conditions</u>: In March the weather was dry and extremely warm. Unstable weather conditions prevailed on the 8<sup>th</sup>, on the 15<sup>th</sup>, on the 24<sup>th</sup> and during the period 28-30 of the month, giving local rain, isolated thunderstorms and hail in some areas. The mean air temperature was approximately 3.5°C above normal and the area average precipitation was 21.6mm or 35% of normal.

<u>Severe Weather conditions</u>: On the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of March extremely high temperatures were recorded in all areas of Cyprus. During the period 25-26 of the month thick dust from North Africa affected the area.

<u>Precipitation (normal period: 1961-1990)</u>: According to preliminary estimates the area average precipitation in March was 21.6mm i.e. 35% of normal. Monthly precipitation was below normal in all areas, generally ranging from 3% (Lefkara) to 73% (Prodromos) of normal.

Hail was recorded on the 29<sup>th</sup> of the month (Stavros Psokas, Pedoulas, Doros, Amiantos, Agros, Agios Theodoros Agrou).

The cumulative area average precipitation during the period October 2017–March 2018 was about 352.1mm, i.e. 80% of normal. The cumulative precipitation was below normal almost in all areas, ranging from 53% (Mathiatis) to 107% (Kouris) of normal.

**Temperature (normal period: 1981-2010):** The mean air temperature for the month was approximately 3.5°C above normal. During the month the mean daily temperatures were above normal. Extremely high temperatures for the month were recorded during the periods 4-8 and 17-23 and on the 27<sup>th</sup> of the month, when maximum temperatures were about 5 to 13° C above normal. Maximum temperatures exceeded 19° C at Athalassa and Larnaka Airport on 31 and 30 occasions respectively. At Prodromos they exceeded 10° C on 30 occasions. Most stations recorded their highest maximum temperature on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of the month and their lowest minimum temperature during the period 2-3 and on the 30<sup>th</sup> of the month.

During the month no air frost or ground frost was recorded in any area of Cyprus.

The 5-day averages of air temperature and their differences from normal at various places are shown in Table 1 and the extreme temperatures are shown in Table 2.
