MONTHLY WEATHER REPORT

THE WEATHER IN AUGUST 2020

General Weather Conditions: In August the weather was extremely hot and dry. Unstable weather conditions occurred during the period 3-4 and on the 12th of the month, giving isolated thundery showers over mountains. The mean air temperature was about 1.5°C above normal and the area average precipitation was 0.4mm i.e. 14% of normal.

<u>Severe weather Conditions</u>: During the periods 1-7 and 12-19, on the 25th and during the period 29-31 of August extremely high temperatures were recorded almost in all areas of Cyprus.

<u>Precipitation (normal period: 1961-1990):</u> According to preliminary estimates, the area average precipitation in August was 0.4mm i.e. 14% of normal. Monthly precipitation ranged from 0% to 233% (Troodos) of normal.

Hail was recorded on the 3rd of the month over Troodos mountains.

The cumulative area average precipitation during the period October 2019 - August 2020 was about 630.9mm, i.e. 14% of normal. The cumulative precipitation was above normal almost in all areas, generally ranging from 93% (Paphos Airport) to 157% (Larnaka Airport) of normal.

Temperature (normal period: 1981-2010): The mean air temperature for the month was about 1.5°C above normal. Mean daily temperatures were below normal during the period 8-11 and on the 22nd of the month, while during the rest of the month they were above or around normal. Extremely high temperatures were recorded during the periods 1-7 and 12-19, on the 25th and during the period 29-31 of the month, when maximum temperatures were about 2°C to 10°C above normal. Heat wave conditions (maximum daily temperature above 40°C) prevailed during the periods 1-2 and 5-7, on the 13th, on the 16th, on the 18th and during the period 29-31 of the month. Maximum temperatures exceeded 37°C at Athalassa on 26 occasions, 33°C at Larnaka Airport on 20 occasions and at Prodromos they exceeded 27°C on 28 occasions. Most stations recorded their highest maximum temperature on the 31st of the month and their lowest minimum temperature on the 10th and during the period 18-21 of the month.

The 5-day averages of air temperature and their deviations from normal at various places are shown in Table 1 and the extreme temperatures are shown in Table 2.
