#### MONTHLY WEATHER REPORT

#### **THE WEATHER IN MARCH 2020**

<u>General Weather Conditions</u>: In March the weather was relatively warm. Unstable weather conditions prevailed during the periods 5-6, 11-13, 16-17, 19-20, 22-25 and 27-31 of the month, giving rain, local thunderstorms, hail and snowfall over mountains. The mean air temperature was approximately 1.5°C above normal and the area average precipitation was 62.0mm or 100% of normal.

<u>Severe Weather conditions:</u> On the 12<sup>th</sup> of the month, severe hailfall with near gale to gale winds affected almost all areas of Cyprus causing damages to properties. During the period 19-20 of the month, extremely low temperatures for the month were recorded in all areas of Cyprus causing damages to plantations.

<u>Precipitation (normal period: 1961-1990):</u> According to preliminary estimates the area average precipitation in March was 62.0mm i.e. 100% of normal. Monthly precipitation was below normal in the western areas, generally ranging from 28% (Limni) to 183% (Panagia Bridge) of normal.

Snowfall was recorded during the periods 16-17 (Troodos, Prodromos, Amiantos, Kyperounta, Pedoulas) and 19-20 (Troodos, Prodromos, Amiantos, Kyperounta, Pedoulas, Omodos) of the month.

Hail was recorded during the periods 16-17 (Kellaki) and 19-20, on the  $25^{th}$  and on the  $27^{th}$  (Meniko) of the month.

The cumulative area average precipitation during the period October 2019 - March 2020 was about 582.2mm, i.e. 133% of normal. The cumulative precipitation was above normal almost in all areas, ranging from 99% (Paphos Airport) to 166% (Pano Polemidia) of normal.

Temperature (normal period: 1981-2010): The mean air temperature for the month was approximately 1.5°C above normal. The mean daily temperatures were below normal during the periods 17-21 and 28-29 of the month, while during the remaining days they were above or around normal. Extremely low temperatures for the month were recorded during the period 19-20 of the month, when maximum and minimum temperatures were about 3-6°C below normal. Maximum temperatures exceeded 19°C at Athalassa and Larnaka Airport on 24 and 23 occasions respectively. At Prodromos they exceeded 10°C on 25 occasions. Most stations recorded their highest maximum temperature during the periods 8-9 and 14-15 and on the 31<sup>st</sup> of the month and their lowest minimum temperature during the period 18-20 of the month.

Air frost was recorded on 7 occasions in the mountainous areas, while ground frost was recorded on 3 occasions in inland areas, on 1 occasion in coastal areas and on 10 occasions in the mountainous areas.

The 5-day averages of air temperature and their deviations from normal at various places are shown in Table 1 and the extreme temperatures are shown in Table 2.
