# **MONTHLY WEATHER REPORT**

#### THE WEATHER IN NOVEMBER 2021

<u>General Weather Conditions</u>: The weather in November was dry and warm. Unstable weather conditions occurred on the 1st, during the periods 3-4, 18-25 and on the 30 of the month, giving showers, local thunderstorms and hail in some areas. The mean air temperature was approximately 2.5°C above normal and the area average precipitation was 30.1mm i.e. 56% of normal.

<u>Severe Weather Conditions:</u> On the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, strong winds caused damages and problems to the power supply in the whole island. On the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of the month, severe rainfall with hail affected the whole island. On the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month, precipitation with strong winds caused floods and damages in properties and roads in Limassol, Paphos districts and mountainous areas. Waterspouts were reported in Paphos.

<u>Precipitation (normal period: 1961-1990):</u> According to preliminary estimates the area average precipitation in November was 30.1mm i.e. 56% of normal. The area average precipitation was below normal almost in all areas of the island and it generally ranged from 10% (Kokkinotrymithia) to 192% (Kato Drys) of normal.

Hail was recorded during the period 18-20 of the month (Alethriko, Troodos). Snow was recorded on the 30th of the month (Troodos).

The cumulative area average precipitation during the period October-November 2021 was about 36.8mm i.e. 43% of normal. In general, the cumulative area average precipitation was below normal to all areas of the island and ranged from 15% (Paphos Airport) to 118% (Kato Drys) of normal.

Temperature (normal period: 1981-2010): The mean air temperature for the month was approximately 2.5°C above normal. Mean daily temperatures were below normal on the 11<sup>th</sup> and during the period 20-21, whereas for the rest of the month they above or around normal. Maximum temperatures exceeded 22°C at Athalassa, Larnaka and Paphos Airport in 28 occasions respectively and at Prodromos they exceeded 13°C on 28 occasions. Most stations recorded their highest maximum temperature during the period 7-8 and on the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month and their lowest minimum temperature on the 12<sup>th</sup> and on the 26<sup>th</sup> of the month.

The 5-day averages of air temperature and their deviations from normal at various places are shown in Table 1 and the extreme temperatures are shown in Table 2.
