




Red

Geographical distinction and terminology







West coast, is defined as the area from cape Gata to cape Arnaoutis, **extending 10 kilometres inland from the coastline**,

- d. Inland, is defined as the area with altitude below 300 meters, at a distance more than 10 kilometres from the coastline.
- e. Highest Mountainous Areas, is defined as the mountainous areas with altitude above 1150 meters.
